A visit to a Zoo

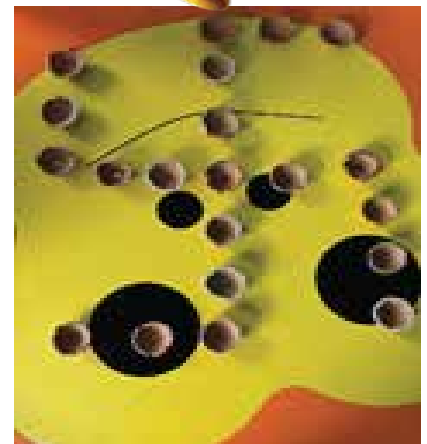

Zig Zag Zoomers



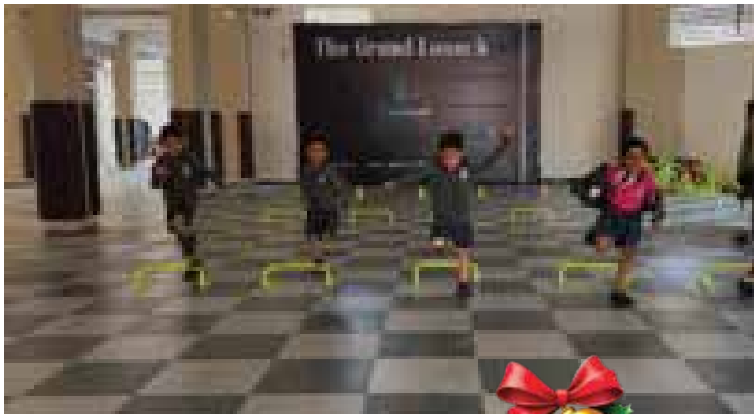
